Summary of the subject:

The purpose of the course is – formation of students' knowledge, awareness and understanding about the patterns of mental activity and individual psychological properties of personality; understanding of the main determinants of personality formation, development and behavior; mastering the basic laws of interpersonal communication; developing skills to understand others, which are based on knowledge of mental processes and rules of effective communication; developing the skills to convey one's opinion and persuade others; formation of students' communicative qualities.

Course objectives:

- to operate with the basic terms and concepts of psychology;
- to apply/use theoretical knowledge of psychology in everyday life;
- to form a complete system of psychological knowledge for students;
- to form a complete system of knowledge and skills for using psychodiagnostic;
- to operate with the psychological knowledge about a person for the analysis of specific life situations;
- to make appropriate decisions in situations that require psychological knowledge;
- analysis of the causes of communication difficulties;
- to form the ability of students to use the psychological knowledge of the course in future professional activities.

Learning outcomes: to offer own ways of solving psychological problems and problems in the process of professional activity; to make and argue own decisions and solutions; to formulate an opinion logically, accessible, to discuss, to defend one's own position; to demonstrate leadership qualities; to be responsible for professional self-improvement, training and self-development; to know and understand the ethical principles of a doctor's professional activity; to diagnose emotional states and personality traits; to distinguish the age psychological characteristics of the individual; to regulate professional communication system with understanding peculiarities of age and individual psychological characteristics; to make a psychological influence to individual in professional communication; to explain the specifics of mental, cognitive and emotional-volitional processes and justify their importance in personal life and doctor's activity.

After studying the course, the student should **know:**

- cognitive processes: sensation, perception, memory, thinking, language, attention, imagination;
- the essence of personality development, it's structure;
- individual psychological traits of personality (temperament, character, abilities);
- features and structure of the emotional and volitional sphere of personality;

- types and methods of adaptation, behavior in a new situation;
- the essence and patterns of personality development;
- the essence of the relationship;
- structure of relationships in a small social group;
- communication and relationship development in ontogenesis;
- communication tactics and strategies, laws and ways of effective communication behavior.

After studying the course, the student should **be able to:**

- be stream-oriented in psychological literature, self-study and analyze scientific literature;
- apply theoretical knowledge in practice, use psychological research methods of interpersonal relationships in the group;
- establishe effective interpersonal interaction.
- distinguish the individual characteristics of mental processes;
- diagnose emotional states and personality traits;
- distinguish the age psychological characteristics of the individual;
- regulate professional communication system with understanding peculiarities of age and individual psychological characteristics;
- make a psychological influence to individual in professional communication;
- explain the specifics of mental, cognitive and emotional-volitional processes and justify their importance in personal life and professional activities;
- participate in scientific discussions, demonstrating both scientific knowledge and own position;
- observe, analyze, summarize and systematize psychological facts, assess the behavior and social actions of individuals;
 - determine the level, adequacy and stability of self-esteem.

- 1. Psychology as a science.
- 2. Characteristics of the cognitive sphere of personality. Sensation and perception as cognitive processes.
- 3. Memory as a cognitive process.
- 3. Cognitive processes of attention and imagination

- 5. Emotions and feelings. Characteristics of the emotional and volitional sphere of personality.
- 6. Characteristics of individual-typological personality traits.
- 7. Medical psychology
